Vision & Mission

Internal Quality Assurance Cell has been established in the institution with a vision of making quality the defining element of higher education in Bhawanipur Anchalik College through a combination of Self and external quality evaluation, promotion and sustenance endeavour with the active support and co-operation of all the stakeholders.

IQAC for Bhawanipur Anchalik College

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell was restructured in April 2012 as per the revised guideline of NAAC, Bangalore. Since then the prime task of the IQAC is to develop system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of the institution. The cell has played a significant role during the First and Second cycle of NAAC Assessment in 2004 and 2015 with C++ & B grade respectively and it has prepared the institution to go for Third cycle of Assessment by inculcating a sense of belongingness and participation in all the constituents for the institution. Over the years the IQAC has become a vehicle for ushering the quality enhancement by working out plan interventionist strategies to remove deficiencies and enhance quality a never ending process.

Keeping the aforesaid vision and mission in mind, the IQAC, Bhawanipur Anchalik College, Bhawanipur has adopted the following strategies and procedure for:

- Ensuring timely, efficient and progressive performance of academic, administrative and financial tasks;
- Serving as a torch-bearer and path finder for the college to bring excellence;
- The relevance and quality of academic research programmes;
- Equitable access to and affordability of academic programmes for various sections of society;
- Optimization and integration of modern methods of teaching and leanings;
- For establishing the credibility of the evaluation procedures;
- Ensuring the adequacy, maintenance and proper allocation of support structure and services;
- Facilitating the creation of a learner centric environment conducive to quality
 education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge for participatory
 teaching and learning process;
- Arrangements of feedback responses from all the stake holders of the institution on quality related process;
- Dissemination of information on various quality parameters of higher education;
- Organisation of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles;

TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS:

PREPARING THE COURSE PLAN:

Bhawanipur Anchalik College, Bhawanipur follows curriculum prepared by Gauhati University at the Under Graduate level for both the Arts and Commerce streams. The course curriculums are implemented in a planned manner through an Academic Calendar of the College prepared by IQAC in consultation with Academic committee of the college based on the Academic Calendar and holiday list of Gauhati University. The Academic calendar prepared by IQAC are uploaded in the college website and incorporated in prospectus of the college. The college prospectus is also uploaded in the website. Based on the Academic Calendar the Academic Committee for the college prepares the class routine and after scrutiny by HoDs it is distributed among the departments. The faculty member through mutual discussion allocates the classes of their departments as per the class routine and circulates it among the students of the departments. The HoDs submit a copy of their departmental class routine to the Principal and Vice-principal of the college. The IQAC encourages the faculty members to prepare individual work load, Teaching Plan and lesson plan. Classes are monitored by the principal and vice principal of the college on regular basis. The grievances relating to the classes, if any, are resolved through discussion in Academic Committee. Class attendance of the students was recorded in a Register Books by the respective departments. It mandatory for every students to remain present for at least75% of classes to appear in the end semester examinations. All the departments keep records of attendance of their students individually.

CURRICULUM TRANSACTION:

For making the teaching learning process interesting along with lecture method the faculty members take ICT enabled classes also. The faculty members of different departments prepare the PPT of some of the Units of the syllabus allotted to them and done their ICT classes accordingly. Moreover, all the departments have their own whatsaap group through which they regularly communicate with the students. Study materials for different courses and other academic information are delivered to the students through their whatsaap group. Some teachers also do their classes through digital platform like Zoom, Google Meet and YouTube channel.

In the syllabus of the courses of each departments book references are well mentioned. However, for the students it is not very easy to follow all the books. The faculty members of the college, at the beginning of each session, gives instruction to the students about the name and author of essential book to be studied by them and which are easily available in

the market and college central library. Some books are also issued to the students from departmental library.

As a part of internal evaluation of the students, they are given home assignment on the course content before every end semester examination. Moreover, the teachers give regular home work to the students to test their understanding in the classes. All the faculty members of the college are participating in the Evaluation Process of End Term Examinations of the university. Bhawanipur Anchalik College have completed nearly 25 evaluation zones of Gauhati University of both Even and Odd Semesters. The faculty members of the college participated in the evaluation process with full dedication which helped in completing the zones in time. Some of the faculty members of the college are the question setter of the university.

The evaluation system consists of both external and internal evaluation of the students. The external evaluation is done through the term end examination for both even and odd semester examinations. In the external evaluation process the faculty members engaged themselves for nearly two months for both even and odd semester examinations. The internal evaluation are done through sessional examinations, home assignments, group discussions, seminars etc for which the faculty members have to engage themselves round the years as a part of continuous evaluation of the students.

LIBRARY AS A LEARNING RESOURCE:

Bhawanipur Anchalik College library was established in the year 1982. At the time of establishment of the college library there were around 1000 books and the same has been increased to 27120 in the year 2022.

The central Library is a well-equipped with computerized network through SOUL software (SQL Server 2008 workgroup) and internet with Wi-Fi facilities. At present the library is well stocked with Books: 27120, Journals: 08, Magazine: 09 and Daily Newspaper 10 of both Assamese and English language.

The has a digital library with a capacity of 10 students at a time. The digital library have 10 computers, one scanner and one printer cum Xerox machine. The students and teachers of the college can access the digital library during the college hours.

The central library is fully automated. A Local Area Network (LAN) using ILMS (Integrated Library Management System) Software for University Libraries (SOUL 2.0 College Version) was installed in the year 2012. This is extensively used for automating in-house activities and services of the library. The Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) is made available for users to identify the status of availability of books and documents in the library. There is a separate reference books section in the library also.

At present the library have 27120 Books, 09 Journals, 315660 E-Books and 7500 E-Journals. Moreover all the institutional publications are available in the college library.

COLLABORATIONS:

All the Departments have signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) with nearby colleges of the district for teacher and faculty exchange programme. Moreover, the

departments also adopted some schools of the locality. In the adopted schools the faculty members take classes and arrange some motivational lecture programme for the students.

USE OF ICT TOOLS FOR EFFECTIVE TEACHING:

An online two day workshop on use of ICT for effective Teaching was organized by the IQAC on 4th & 5th June, 2021 in association with TLC, Tezpur University. The inaugural session of the workshop was addressed by the Director of TLC, Tezpur University and Principal of Bhawanipur Anchalik College, Bhawanipur. The workshop was basically organized for the teachers of Bhawanipur Anchalik College. All the faculty members including the part time faculty participated in the workshop. The well trained faculties of Tezpur University were the resource persons of the workshop. In the first day there was five sessions including the inaugural sessions. The contents covered in the first day were Google Classroom: Set up and Management, E-content Creation in Four Quadrant Approach, Screencasting Software for E- content Creationand handson practice by the participants.
