## $1^{\text {st }}$ Year ( $1^{\text {st }}$ Semester= $\mathbf{2 2}$ Credits)

Core Course : For the completion of the admission process under GU-FYUGP, students of all streams are to select : subject-1 of 4 credits,
subject-2 of 4 credits,
subject-3 of 4 credits as
MAJOR+MINOR-1+MINOR-2.
Common Courses: Students are to select :
VAC-1 of 2 credits,
Multidisciplinary-1 of 3 credits
AEC-1 of 2 credits
SEC-1 of 3 credits

## $1^{\text {st }}$ Year (2 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ Semester= 22 Credits)

Core Course : For the completion of the admission process under GU-FYUGP, students of all streams are to select : subject-1 of 4 credit,
subject-2 of 4 credit,
subject-3 of 4 credit as
MAJOR+MINOR-1+MINOR-2.
Common Courses : Students are to select :
VAC-2 of 2 credits,
Multidisciplinary-2 of 3 credits
AEC-2 of 2 credits
SEC-1 of 3 credits

All Students are to select subjects from the subject pool available in the College which are as the following-

## What You are to DO ?

STEP-1 $>$ Select any Stream of your choice (Science/Arts/Commerce)
STEP-2 $>$ You are to select THREE (03) subjects as CORE (Both for MAJOR and MINOR) Courses both for Science and Arts.
**Students of Commerce Stream are to select only the MAJOR CORE.
A) For B.A. ${ }^{\text {st }}$ Semester : All students are to Select subjects from THREE GROUPS as per own choice : One(1) as MAJOR CORE and Two(2) for MINOR CORE.

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* GROUP-I : MIL (Only ASSAMESE)
* GROUP-II: Other Languages (ENGLISH/ARABIC)
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* GROUP-III : Social Science (Any One/Two/Three from ECONOMICS, EDUCATION, HISTORY, PHILOSOPHY, POLITICAL SCIENCE )
***Suppose A student has selected Assamese as Major he/she is to select any two subjects as Minor from GROUP-II and GROUP-III.
*** If A student has selected English as Major he/she is to select any two subjects as Minor from GROUP-I, GROUP-II and GROUP-III.
*** If A student has selected EDUCATION as Major he/she is to select any two subjects as Minor from GROUP-I, GROUP-II and GROUP-III.

Note: For the selection of subject/subjects as MAJOR and MINOR for CORE Course students required to study the subject/subjects in Higher Secondary Level. No student can select any subject either as MAJOR or MINOR which he/she has not studied in Higher Secondary Level.


#### Abstract

B) For B.Com. $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ Semester : All students are to Select ONE Subject for MAJOR CORE from the under mentioned Subject Pool and the selection of other subjects will be as the selection of BA/B.Sc. courses.


* Major Core I : ACCOUNTANCY
* Major Core II : FINANCE
* Major Core III : HUMAN RESOURCE \& MANAGEMENT
* Major Core IV : MARKETING MANAGEMENT

Note: For the selection of subject/subjects as MAJOR and MINOR for CORE Course students required to study the subject/subjects in Higher Secondary Level. No student can select any subject either as MAJOR or MINOR which he/she has not studied in Higher Secondary Level.
C) For B.Sc $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ Semester : All students are to Select Subjects from TWO GROUPS as per own choice : One(1) as MAJOR CORE and Two(2) for MINOR CORE.

* Group-I : Physical Science (Any One/Two/Three from PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY and MATHEMATICS)
* GROUP-II: Biological Science (Any One/Two from BOTANY and ZOOLOGY)
***Suppose A student has selected Physics as Major he/she is to select any two as Minor from GROUP-I and GROUP-II.
*** If A student has selected Botany as Major he/she is to select any two subjects as Minor from GROUP-I and GROUP-II.

Note: For the selection of subject/subjects as MAJOR and MINOR for CORE Course students required to study the subject/subjects in Higher Secondary Level. No student can select any subject either as MAJOR or MINOR which he/she has not studied in Higher Secondary Level.

STEP-3> Now come to COMMON Course. All students are to select FOUR (4) subjects from Four Pools such as (Value Added Course, Ability Enhancement Course, Multidisciplinary and Skill Enhancement Course).
Courses Available under the caption as
A) Value Added Course : Students of all streams (Arts/Commerce/ Science) are to select Environmental Studies of Two credits as Compulsory in $1^{\text {st }}$ Semester.
In $2^{\text {nd }}$ Semester as Value Added Course students are to select subject as per the decision of the Affiliating University.
B) Ability Enhancement Course : All students are to select One (1) subject as Ability Enhancement Course of Two credits from the subjects pool specified herewith-
i) MIL (Assamese)

## ii) English Communication

C) Multidisciplinary : All students of all streams are to select One (1) subject as Multidisciplinary of Three credits Course from the Subjects Pool specified herewith-
i) Natural \& Physical Science : Physics \& Astronomy, Chemistry, Biological Science, and Earth Science.
ii) Mathematical Science : Basic Mathematics and Statistics
iii) Computer Application : Introductory Computer Applications and Programming, Information Technology
iv) Commerce \& Management : Basic Business Management, Introductory Commerce
v) Humanities \& Social Science : Basic Economics, Political Science, History, Philosophy, and Psychology, Women's and Gender Studies
D) Skill Enhancement Course : Students of all streams (Arts/Commerce/Science) Major and Minor select one (1) Skill Paper of Three (3) credits from the Subjects Pool as per the decision of the Affiliating University.
Note: 1.During the time of selection of Courses under the caption Value Added Course, Ability Enhancement Course, Multidisciplinary and Skill Enhancement Course all students are to keep in mind that they are not allowed to select any subject which they have already selected as CORE Courses
2. Students would select such a subject which he/she has not studied in Higher Secondary Level.

## Special Note:

1. All Students are to select subject as MAJOR and MINOR which they have already studied in Higher Secondary Level
2. No students are allowed to select subjects as Value Added Course, Ability Enhancement Course, Multidisciplinary and Skill Enhancement Course which they have studied in Higher Secondary Level.
3. Students who will select any subject as MAJOR they are to study the subject as First Core in Semester-1.
4. All Students who have selected their MAJOR subject during the time of admission are to study the subject as MAJOR in Semester-3.

Total Credits are to be studied as Subject-1 of 4 credits, Subject-2 of 4 Credits, Subject-3 of 4 Credits, VAC of 2 credits, Multidisciplinary of 3 credits, AEC of 2 credits and SEC of 3 credits $=$ 22 Credits
$\nleftarrow$ General Information : MAJOR seats are limited in each subject. Therefore, priority will be given on the basis of Merit.
$\rightarrow$ For any doubt before finalization of subject selection, students may take the guidance from the admission helpdesk of the college.
